Dr. Dennis Paustenbach is currently the President of ChemRisk, a human and ecological risk assessment consulting firm with four offices nationwide. He was previously the President of McLaren-Hart, a 600 person consulting environmental engineering firm and was a Vice President at Exponent (formerly Failure Analysis Associates). He was the founder of ChemRisk, the largest risk-assessment consulting firm in the U.S. during the 1990's and has resurrected the firm as of June 2003. He earned a BS in Chemical Engineering, an MS in industrial hygiene/toxicology, and a Ph.D. in Environmental Toxicology. He is board-certified in toxicology, industrial hygiene, and safety and has more than 20 years of experience in risk assessment, environmental engineering, ecotoxicology, and occupational health. Dennis has specialized in exposure assessment and dose reconstruction for much of the past 15 years and has published about 40 articles and 7 book chapters on the topic. He has presented guest lectures and short courses on exposure assessment throughout the United States and at least five other countries. He has been an adjunct professor at several universities and was a visiting scholar at the Center for Risk Analysis at Harvard. Dennis has directed consulting activities for nearly 700 risk assessments and has published more than 250 peer-reviewed manuscripts in this and related fields. He is the editor of the most popular text book on risk assessment, "Human and Ecological Risk Assessment: Theory and Practice." Dr. Paustenbach was identified as the best Risk Practitioner within the Society of Risk Analysis in 1998 and was awarded the Arnold J. Lehman award by the Society of Toxicology in 2002 in recognition of his contributions to the field of risk assessment.
