Short curriculum vitae

Professor Dunnigan studied at the University of Ottawa where he obtained his B.Sc. degree in 1960, and his Ph. D. degree in physiology in 1963.

After two years of post-doctoral research in the Department of Biochemistry of the Faculty of Medicine at Université Laval in Québec City, he went to University of Sherbrooke where he became professor and tutor of graduate students, Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Sciences and Associate University Vice-President for research.

In 1982, he became interested in asbestos research, and for some 13 years was the Director of the Health & Environment Division of the Asbestos Institute.

He is the author of some 60 research papers, and has travelled extensively abroad as a guest speaker in international conferences, university seminars etc.

From 1993, Professor Dunnigan served as Chairman of the Graduate Programme in Environmental Sciences at the University of Sherbrooke until he retired in 1996.
