Luis Cejudo Alva started his college education at Harris Technical College in Saint Louis Missouri, U.S.A.

Later on, he proceeded to study architecture at the Technische Hochschule, in Vienna Austria (1953 to 1958).

He took post graduate courses at the American University of Lebanon, Beirut and he worked on community home construction buildings while living in Lebanon for three years.

Back in Mexico, City, he worked at the Industrial Kaiser Co. Among some achievements, as Technical Director, he introduced the gypsum panel sheetrock in Mexico and developed a design and method for the construction of light-weight concrete roofs.

Thirty four years ago, Luis, in coordination with asbestos cement companies started the activities of the Mexican Fibre Cement Industry Association.

Sixteen years ago, in order to extend chrysotile safe use practices and regulations to all branches of asbestos Luis founded the Mexican Fibre Industries Institute, where he remains today as President.

Beginning this year, instead of retiring, Luis took over again the Mexican Fibre Industries Association as General Director

Among other national and international achievements, he is today President of the Chrysotile Latin American Association, and takes an important role at the Executive Committee of the world wide International Chrysotile Association.
